You should complete Durham County Council's separate Application for Free School Transport if you believe you will qualify for free transport from them.</li> <li>3. To be certain of being allocated a seat, we need to receive your application by 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018.</li> <li>4. Students will not be allowed to travel on the school bus without a valid pass.</li> </ol>
